Gilbert Kennedy

1st Bn., Royal Munster Fusiliers who died on 11 December 1918 Age 32

Son of the late R. M. Kennedy, I.C.S., Bombay Pres. and Mrs. Kennedy, of Sutton, Surrey; husband of Eileen Kennedy, of 11, Evelyn Court, Cheltenham. Born at Kaira, Bombay. Educated at Oundle and Sandhurst. 4th Gurkhas, 1907. Joined North Staffords, 1914. Engaged Mahsuds at Bannu, India, 1914. Transf. to Royal Munster Fusiliers. Fought at Loos, Somme and Aisne, 1916. Cambrai, 1917. Attd. 1st American Corps School as Instructor, 1918.
