

GERALD WALLACE ADAM was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. J. W. Adam of Heaton Moor, Stockport, and now of Buxton. He was born at Stockport on May 15, 1899, and entered Oundle (Grafton House) in May 1914. Leaving in December 1916, Adam joined the Manchester University O.T.C. in January 1917, and was eventually gazetted to the 3rd (Reserve) Battalion of the Leicestershire Regiment.

In June 1918 he was attached to the 13th Yorkshire Regiment and with them went to Russia.

In May 1919 he was appointed Intelligence and Code Officer on Colonel Lavie's Staff.

He died on active service in Northern Russia, on August 10, 1919.
