

CHARLES EDWARD ANDREWS was the only son of the late W. Price Andrews of Leeds. He was born at Gibraltar in August 1871.

He came to Oundle in January 1887, entering Laxton House, and left in December 1889, having played for the XV in his last year.

He was mentioned in despatches in January 1916.

At the time of his death in action, on October 25, 1916, he held the rank of Major in the Highland Light Infantry.

He was married.
