

**J**OHN BROADWOOD ATKINSON was the third son of Mr. and Mrs. J. Atkinson of Annaghmore, Portadown. He was born in London on October 1, 1894, and entered Oundle (Grafton House) in January 1909. At school he was a keen member of the Officers' Training Corps, being Section Commander for his house.

Joining the Royal Irish Fusiliers he went with them (the 5th battalion) to Gallipoli. He was wounded in the landing at Suvla Bay on August 6, 1915, and was moved to Alexandria. Enteric fever supervened, and he died on Christmas Eve (1915).

At the time when he was wounded he had been appointed temporary Captain.
