

HENRY KENYON BAGSHAW was the eldest son of the Rev. H. F. and Mrs. Bagshaw of Chatteris. He was born on January 7, 1892, at Knighton (Radnorshire).

He was for a time at school at Hunstanton before coming to Oundle and entering New House in January 1908. Leaving in July 1909 he took up land agency work.

In September 1914 he joined the Public Schools Corps and later obtained a commission in the Army Service Corps, having failed to get into the infantry through defective eyesight.

He served in France with the A.S.C. 1915 and 1916, and became full Lieutenant. In 1917 he was attached to the Duke of Wellington's West Riding Regiment and saw several months' service at the front before his death in action near Ypres on April 13, 1918.
