

**A**USTIN PROVOST BALDWIN was the second son of Mrs. Baldwin of Peterborough and was born at Great Barton on November 27, 1882. He entered Oundle in September 1893, and left in July 1899.

He joined the Artists' Rifles in July 1917 and went to Romford Camp, proceeding in December to Pirbright. He was gazetted Second Lieutenant on June 2, 1918, and went to France in August 1918. He was killed at Flesquières, near Cambrai, on September 27, by machine gun fire. It was his first time in action.
