

HUGH WILLIAM EAMES BARWELL was the eldest son of Mr. and Mrs. William Barwell of Edgbaston, and was born at Harborne on October 16, 1892.

He entered Oundle (Sidney House) in January 1907 and left in July 1911.

Representing the school both at cricket and football, he was also a keen hockey player, and after leaving school was a member of the Warwickshire Team.

In July 1914 he graduated B.Sc. of Birmingham University, where he was a member of the O.T.C. He received a commission in the Royal Warwickshire Regiment soon after the outbreak of war and was promoted Captain in 1915. In November 1916 he was awarded the Military Cross and also the Croix de Guerre. In July 1917 he transferred to the Flying Corps and was reported missing on March 25, 1918, his death being subsequently presumed to have occurred on that date.
