

HUMPHREY EAMES BARWELL was the third son of Mr. and Mrs. William Barwell of Edgbaston, Birmingham, and was born at Harborne on September 23, 1898.

He entered Oundle (Sidney House) in September 1912, and left at Christmas 1916.

Barwell played several times for the XI in 1916, and was a member of the second football team.

In 1917 he joined the Royal Flying Corps, and was killed on February 3, 1918.
