

**W**ILLIAM JOHN BOARD was the eldest son of Mr. and Mrs. W. J. Board of Nottingham. He was born at Cardiff on March 1, 1899. He came to Oundle from Wolverley School, Worcester, entering Dryden in September 1914.

Leaving school in July 1916, early in the following year he joined the Nottingham University O.T.C., in which Corps he attained the rank of Sergeant. Subsequently he trained with the R.F.A. at Weedon and Lark Hill.

He received his commission in March 1918, and was attached to a Reserve Brigade in Ireland until August of that year, when he proceeded overseas (to the Bulgarian front). He died of wounds received on September 18, 1918, while taking up ammunition to the fighting line.
