

ROBERT CHARLES BRAGG was the second son of Professor Sir W. H. Bragg, of University College, London, and formerly of Leeds. He was born at Adelaide on November 25, 1892.

He entered Dryden in May 1909 and remained until December 1911.

Bragg was a school prefect, a member of the Fifteen and of the crew, being Captain of Boating in 1911.

At the time of his death from wounds, on September 13, 1915, he was Lieutenant in the R.F.A.
