

**CLIVE BURRELL** was the fifth son of Mr. and Mrs. E. R. Burrell of Blackheath, where he was born on August 14, 1893. He entered the school (Dryden House), in September 1907 and left in July 1910. He was school cox for two years.

After leaving school he entered his father's business and eventually became a Director.

He joined the H.A.C. in March 1917 and, after training at Finsbury Park and Leeds, went to France on 5 September, when he was attached as a driver to one of the H.A.C. Batteries. He saw much fighting in 1918, but in November he contracted influenza, and, pneumonia following, he died in the Canadian Hospital, Valenciennes, on November 23, 1918.
