

WILLIAM MICHELL CLARKE was the younger son of Dr. and Mrs. Clarke of Clifton, Bristol. He was born on November 17, 1896, and entered Oundle (Grafton House) in January 1911, leaving in July 1915.

Leaving school he joined the ranks of the South Midland Royal Engineers, and received his commission in October 1915. He went to France in the September following, and was killed in action on November 11, 1916.
