

IVOR THEOPHILUS DAVIES was the third son of Mr. and Mrs. T. A. Davies of Southgate, and was born at Hampstead on October 4, 1894.

He entered the Berrystead in September 1905, being transferred to Laxton House in September 1907.

He left school in July 1913, having played for the XI in his last term.

Soon after war broke out he was given a commission in the Oxford and Buckinghamshire Light Infantry, with whom he proceeded to France. He was killed in action at Bellewaarde, near Hooze, on June 22, 1915, and was buried by the Germans.
