

HUGH COURTNEY DAVIS was the third son of the late E. C. Davis of Calcutta and Mrs. Maud Davis of Larklands, St. Margaret's Bay, Dover.

He was born in London on May 3, 1897.

He entered Oundle (New House) in September 1911.

In the spring of 1915 he received a commission in the Royal Berkshire Regiment, but in March 1916 he was attached to the Royal Flying Corps and received his wings in July (1916).

He went to the front on August 1, and met with a fatal accident on returning to his aerodrome from patrol duty on 5 August, 1916.
