

COLIN HAROLD GODWIN was the eldest son of the late Dr. G. L. Godwin and of Mrs. Godwin, Dalkoosha, Clowne, Derbyshire. He was born at Claycross on July 27, 1893, and entered Oundle (Crosby House) in January 1909, staying until December 1911. He was in the elevens of 1910 and 1911.

After leaving school he studied medicine at Sheffield University, and when war broke out he enlisted in the Sheffield City Battalion, receiving his commission in the York and Lancaster Regiment a few months later. He was killed in action on July 1, 1916.
