CHARLES SHORTLAND GRAY was the son of C. Gray, Esq., of Stamford.
He was born on July 12, 1892, and entered Oundle (Crosby

House) in May 1906, leaving in December 1909.

He was killed on October 13, 1915. His body was picked up a fortnight after the battle lying at the head of his men.

He held the rank of Captain in the Lincolnshire Regiment.
