

JOHAN PARNWELL GRAY was the second son of Mr. and Mrs. C. G. Gray of St. Mary's Hill, Stamford, where he was born on April 14, 1898.

He entered Oundle (Crosby House) in September 1911, and left in July 1915.

He held a commission in the R.F.A., and was killed in action in September 1918.

His rank at the time of his death was Lieutenant.
