

**H**UGH CECIL GRUMMITT was the second son of Mr. and Mrs. H. J. Grummitt of Hornsea, East Yorkshire, where he was born on November 21, 1898. He entered Dryden in September 1913.

He served in the ranks of the Queen's Westminsters for eight months prior to taking a commission in the East Yorkshire Regiment in May 1918. He served in France with the 1st Battalion until he was wounded on August 26, and invalided to England.

Leaving hospital he rejoined the 4th (Reserve) Battalion of the East Yorkshires, and was with them up to the time of his last illness, due to heart failure.

He died in the Brooklands Hospital, Hull, on March 25, 1919.
