

LAWRENCE COLLIER HATCH was the second son of Dr. and Mrs. F. H. Hatch of Copsehill, Wimbledon. Born at Johannesburg on November 3, 1893, he entered Oundle (School House) in January 1907 and was at school until July 1911.

Leaving Oundle he went up to Pembroke, Cambridge.

At the outbreak of war he obtained a commission in the Durham Light Infantry, with whom he went to France in September 1915, his rank being Lieutenant.

He was killed a week later at the battle of Loos.
