

**P**HILIP RANDALL HATCH was the eldest son of Dr. and Mrs. F. H. Hatch of Copschill, Wimbledon, and was born on February 24, 1892.

He entered Oundle (School House) in September 1906. Leaving school in July 1910 he went up to Christ's College, Cambridge, where he took the diploma in agriculture.

In August 1914 he was continuing his studies in Denmark; he threw up his work there and returned home to join the army. Given a commission in the East Kent Regiment (December 1914), at the time of his death on October 7, 1916, he was acting Captain.

He fell in action at the head of his Company.
