

GUY STEVENSON HEWITT was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. Edgar Hewitt of Banfield, Buxton, and was born on March 10, 1898, at Wilmslow.

He entered Grafton in May 1912, and left in July 1915. Entering Sandhurst in September 1916, he went to France in March 1917 with the Artists Rifles, and was there for a year. He was killed in action near Cambrai on March 8, 1918.
