

JOHN HOLLICK was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. T. D. Hollick of Upminster, Essex. He was born at Ingatestone on January 23, 1899.

He entered Sidney House in September 1913.

Leaving Oundle in July 1917, he joined the R.N.A.S., and on November 12 was appointed Flight Sub-Lieutenant. He went to France in January 1918, and did good work continuously until he was reported missing on May 18, 1918. Shortly before his death he was recommended for promotion.

He was last seen in conflict with several German aeroplanes, about ten miles over the German lines near Sailly-sur-Lys, south of Armentières.
