

HUGH JAMES PEARSON HOPKINSON was the eldest son of Mr. and Mrs. F. I. Hopkinson of Hull and London. He was born in Devonshire on July 7, 1892.

Entering Oundle (Sidney House) in September 1906, he left the school in 1909. Keen at games, he played for the XI. After leaving school he was articled to his father, who was engineer for the Hull Joint Dock. While at Hull he was member of the Hull and East Riding Football Team.

He went out to Gallipoli as a Lieutenant in the Royal Engineers.

On the night of November 5, 1915, he was superintending the laying of wire entanglements in front of the trenches, and was shot while bandaging a wounded man. He died on the way to the dressing station.
