

**W**ALTER MAYNARD HOYLE was the only son of the late Mr. J. Johnson Hoyle, solicitor, of Johannesburg, and of Mrs. Hoyle, the Fields, Newport, Monmouthshire. He was born on May 16, 1898, and was for a time at St. John's College, Johannesburg, before coming to England and entering Oundle (Laxton House) in May 1915.

Leaving school in July 1916, he passed into Sandhurst, and was eventually gazetted to the Norfolk Regiment on April 30, 1917. He was taken ill with pneumonia the same day, and died at the Cottage Hospital, Weybridge, Surrey, on May 11, 1917.
