

**C**EDRIC ARTHUR JACKSON was the third son of Mr. and Mrs. W. F. Jackson of Dore, Sheffield, where he was born on February 17, 1893. He entered Grafton House in May 1908, and left in April 1910.

On the outbreak of war Jackson joined the 12th York and Lancaster Regiment as a private. He was eventually promoted corporal and in May 1915 was given his commission in the same regiment, and acted as Bomb Officer.

He served in Egypt and then in France, being promoted Lieutenant in February 1917. In August of the same year he transferred to the Flying Corps, and was accidentally killed while flying at Dover on November 5, 1917.
