

**C**ECIL DARLEY FARREN LEACH was the second son of Mr. and Mrs. J. F. Leach of Pendleton, Manchester, and was born on November 22, 1892.

He came to Oundle (Crosby House) in September 1906 remaining until July 1909.

On leaving school he took up banking and at the time of the outbreak of war was in the London House of the Mercantile Bank of India. He was a keen cricket and hockey player.

Obtaining a commission in the North Staffordshire Regiment, he was with the second battalion at Rawal Pindi.

He was accidentally killed on March 2, 1918, his rank at the time being Lieutenant.
