

WILLIAM REGINALD MATTHEWS was the eldest son of Mr. and Mrs. H. M. Matthews of Sutherland Avenue, Maida Vale. He was born at Ealing on August 25, 1878.

Coming to Oundle in January 1895 he entered Sidney, where he remained until the end of the summer term.

He was accidentally killed in April 1916.

At the time of his death he was a Second Lieutenant in the South African Railways and Harbours Rifles.
