

RICHARD HENRY MOORE was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. R. H. Moore of Bournemouth.

He was born at Blundellsands on May 19, 1898.

He entered Oundle (Laxton House) in January 1913 and left in July 1916. In his last summer at school he played for the XI.

In March 1917 he entered the Royal Military Academy, Woolwich, and was given a commission in the R.F.A. on January 24, 1918, proceeding to France on February 6.

He was fatally wounded on March 21, after six weeks in France.
