

ALAN LEWIS PINK was the eldest son of the late J. F. Pink of London, and Mrs. Pink of Chennell's House, Horsham. Hewas born in London on August 23, 1898, and entered Oundle (Laxton House) in September 1911. Later he was transferred to New House. He was a member of the XV.

Leaving school in April 1915, he obtained a commission in the Rifle Brigade. Later he was attached to the Royal Air Force, and was killed in action on October 30, 1918.

His rank at the time of his death was Lieutenant.
