

**W**ILFRID REDFERN was the second son of the late W. G. Redfern of Brough, East Yorkshire, and Mrs. Redfern of Scarborough.

He was born at Elloughton on July 26, 1887, and entered Oundle (School House) in April 1898.

Leaving in December 1904, he was later in his father's business at Hull, where he was a keen cricket and hockey player.

In August 1914 Redfern enlisted in the 10th Royal Fusiliers and went with them to France. In November 1915 he was sent to England to take a commission in the 8th East Yorkshire Regiment. He was severely wounded in July 1916. He was killed on March 22, 1918, being shot by a sniper as he was handing over his company after a day's severe fighting. He was promoted captain in the autumn of 1917.
