

JOHN HENRY WILCOCK RHODES was the third son of the late W. Rhodes of Gomersal, Leeds. He was born at Birstal on February 10, 1881, and came to Oundle in May 1894, leaving school in July 1897.

He entered Dryden House.

Rhodes came over from Australia with the 22nd Battalion of the Australian Infantry, and went with them to Gallipoli, where he received wounds of which he died on August 4, 1915.
