

JAMES STUART RICKETTS was the eldest son of the late Dr. T. E. Ricketts of Dartford, Kent, and Mrs. Ricketts of St. Leonard's-on-Sea, Sussex.

He was born at Greenhithe on May 30, 1894, and came to Oundle in May 1909, leaving in July 1913. He entered Dryden House.

After leaving school he passed through the Royal Military Academy, Woolwich, and was gazetted to the R.F.A.

He died of wounds in October 1918, after great suffering, and having won the affection of all who saw him by his cheerfulness and patience.
