

**J**OHN VERCOE ROGERS was the second son of Mr. and Mrs. T. Rogers of Canonbury Park, London.

He was born in London on March 18, 1886, and entered Oundle (Sidney House) in January 1898, leaving in December 1900.

Rogers came over with the Canadians and held the rank of lieutenant in the 68th battalion of the Winnipeg Grenadiers.

He fell in action in November 1918—just before the Armistice.
