

**A** RTHUR HOWARD BARTLETT STACE was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. H. P. Stace of the Croft, Brackley.

He was born at Brackley on February 28, 1899, and entered Oundle (Crosby House) in September 1913, leaving in April 1917.

He was a member of the XV and captain of boating.

Stace joined the Air Force and went to France in September 1918, joining the 25th Squadron. During his six weeks of active service before the Armistice, his work was chiefly reconnaissance and photography. He was accidentally killed while flying, on May 3, 1919.

His Commanding Officer described him as a most efficient officer and a keen sportsman.
