

EDWARD ALFRED MURTAGH STEVENS was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. E. Stevens of Pakhoi, S. China. He was born on September 24, 1898, and entered Oundle (Grafton House) in January 1913, leaving in July 1916.

He was a member of the XI in 1916.

Stevens held a commission in the East Kent Regiment and won the Military Cross.

He was killed on July 2, 1918.
