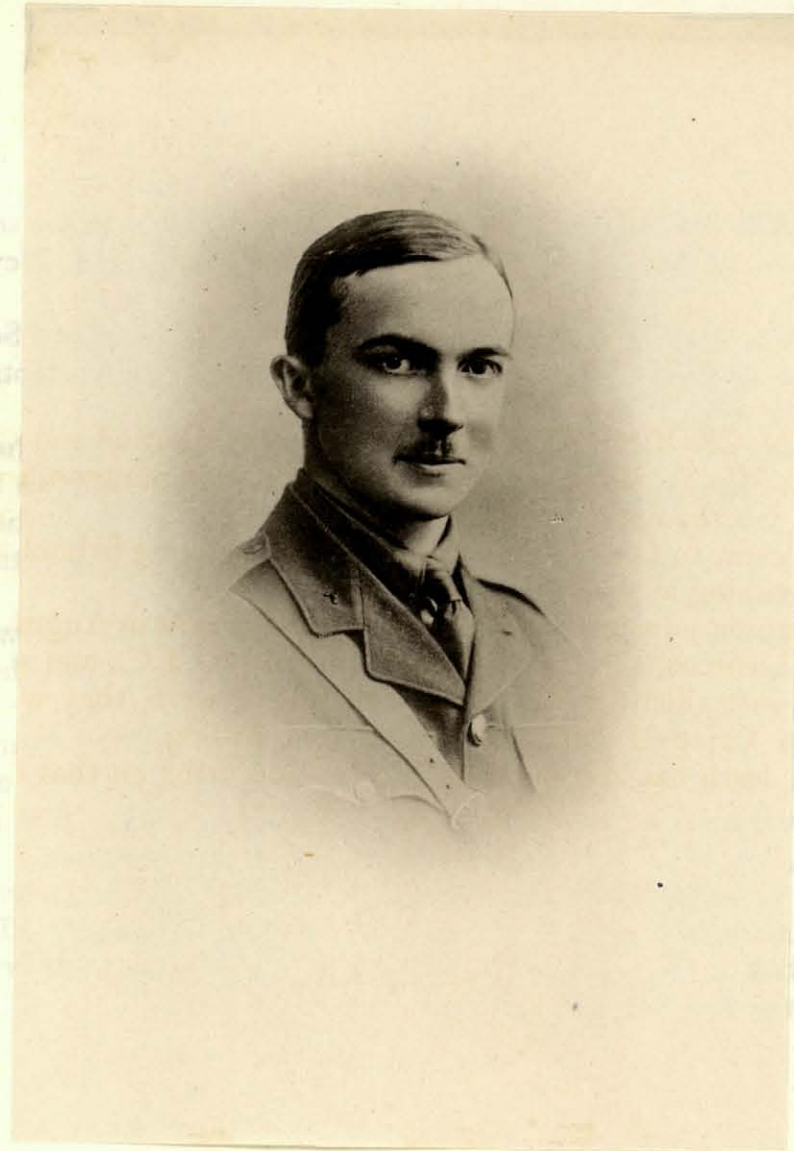


JOHN CROCKETT STIMPSON was the second son of Mr. and Mrs. A. Stimpson of Cheyne Walk, Northampton, and was born at Northampton on May 11, 1897.

He came to Oundle in September 1911, entering School House and remaining at school until July 1913.

Stimpson joined the West Yorkshire Regiment in August 1915 as 2nd Lieutenant from the Leeds University O.T.C., and went to France with them in May 1916. On July 1, 1916, they were engaged at Thiepval, when he was reported missing.

His death has been presumed to have occurred on that date.
