

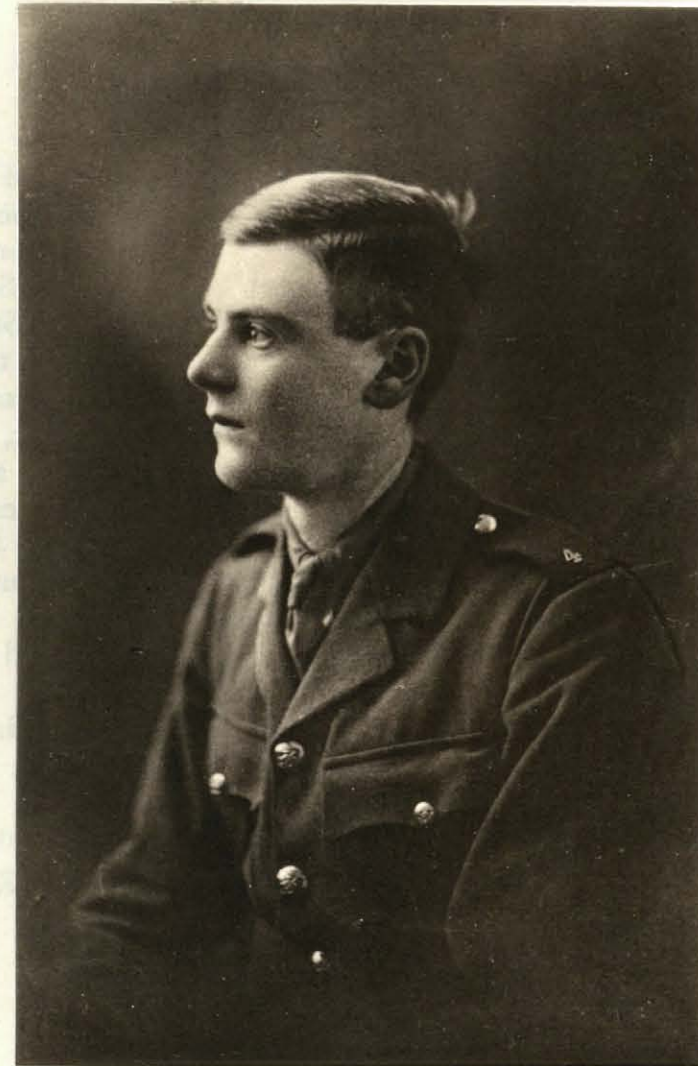
**E**DWARD WILMOT VAUGHAN was the only son of the late John Percival Vaughan, I.C.S., and the late Mrs. Helen Mabel Vaughan, who died at Kingston, Ontario, Canada, in April 1915. He was a grandson of Mrs. Vaughan of Llangoedmore, Cardiganshire.

Born on September 8, 1896, he came to Oundle in September 1910, and left in July 1913, to accompany his mother to Canada. He played for the XI.

At the time of his mother's death Vaughan was a cadet at the Ontario Military College. He came back to England with his sister to make their home with his uncle and guardian, Mr. H. M. Vaughan of Llangoedmore.

He joined the R.F.A. and went to France, where he died on July 15, 1916, of wounds received the same day.

An officer wrote: "I am very sorry to lose him. . . . He was very keen and was learning his job fast, and for a lad just out for the first time he was wonderfully fearless."
