

THOMAS LOVELL WARNER was the elder son of Mrs. Warner of Willowdene, London Road, Leicester. He was born at Leicester on January 11, 1894, and came to Oundle in January 1908, entering New House. Warner was a school prefect and a prominent member of the XV.

Leaving in 1913 he went up to Caius College, Cambridge. In September 1914 he obtained a commission in the 8th Battalion the Leicestershire Regiment, and went to France in July 1915, and was wounded twice, in July 1916 and in May 1917. He was mentioned three times in despatches, obtained his majority in February 1917, and was awarded the D.S.O. in November 1917.

He died at Tincourt, near Peronne on December 29, 1917, from appendicitis and dysentery.
