

BASIL HERBERT WATTS was the fifth son of the Rev. J. Watts of Allingborough Rectory, Wellingborough. He was born at Croundale on March 12, 1879, and entered Oundle (Sidney House) in January 1894. He was a member of the XV of 1896 and the XI of 1897.

Being in Canada when the war broke out, Watts joined the Canadian Infantry, and came over with an early contingent. He was killed near Ypres on April 18, 1915.
