Using the online archive

The Oundle Online Archive contains numerous items including School photographs, The School Registers 1626-1928, The Laxtonian: The Oundle School Chronicle and informative articles from The Archive.

The 'War Years' includes the memorials of The Great War 1914-1919 and the Second World War with an 'A - Z' Old Oundelians Roll of Honour.

Various documents and photographs will be added to the Online Archive on a regular basis.

The Search facility within the Archive provides the user with the option of entering a specific search query or using the built-in functions provided. Results are displayed as tabular format or thumbnails which may be selected to view the original document or photograph image.

The system uses a browse screen function to enable the user to navigate through the archive, once logged into the archive the main 'Browse' screen will appear and from this screen the user may select the required section.


Easy to use navigation buttons allow the user to quickly switch between the browse screens and by just clicking on the different thumbnails you will be able to open the next screen.

Photographs are available to view as individual photographs in date order.

Registers and Books are split down to Chapters and Pages to enable quick viewing of the files.

The Memorials of The Great War 1914-1919 and the Second World War have been allocated sections for easy viewing.

'The Roll of Honour' is set out in an A - Z system, which enables the user to locate the entries for the fallen quickly and efficiently.
